

PREAMBLE

This write up is not meant for those that like to skim through scriptures but for those that dig deep into the Bible and have a good database of the Words of God in them already. For you to truly benefit from this discuss you must be ready and prepared to read, study and meditate on EVERY ONE of the Biblical verses contained therein. It is not for you to assume it but to read it yourself wherever they pop up. This write up is not a novel or just another good informational read but a digging deep kind of thing. For those that operate carnally majorly, and who focus on the letter and are unable to discern the spirit behind the letters of scriptures, such will find this write up difficult to comprehend because it is spiritually discerned, be warned. If you do not generally like opening up the Bible to see what is written in it as listed this discuss will not benefit you maximally, please also be advised. Acts 17:10-12.

INTRODUCTION

It has been truly said that after God created the heaven and earth in six days, on the seventh day he rested from the creation of all the work of his hands but ever since He made Woman, God and Man have not rested ever since. The question is why? And it is a question that seems yet to remain unanswered or people shy away from speaking the truth even as the Bible says it in order not to cause offence with the women folks, but this ought not to be so. The truth is a hard saying and ought to be said as it is though not everyone will accept it. Jn 6:60,61,66

Any discuss on the subject Woman cannot be said to be exhaustive because of the seeming complexity of that gender which even they themselves cannot fathom out explicitly. The Woman is a character that one cannot readily ignore in the history of mankind on earth. An in-depth understanding of her origin and conception is

required to be able to navigate through the intricate maze of her constitution and web of operations on earth as it were.

In this write up, we shall treat the subject matter from a dispassionate perspective in order to as much as possible unravel who the woman truly is, which is somehow still wrapped in mystery till today. We shall be discussing scripturally and spiritually, not letter-wise or emotionally in order not to still end up in the same merry go round quagmire of today due to respect of persons while yet remaining in the same error that perpetuates the mystery. Those that have the Spirit of truth in them as they hear the truth contained therein shall identify with it rather than oppose it to their own conceit and detriment. The Truth only remains hard to those that operate in error and prefer to continue in error still.

For a foundational insight into who a Woman is, an in depth spiritual revelation of what must have transpired in the Garden of Eden prior to her coming forth has to be unraveled if not we will still remain in the erroneous understanding that seems to be the order of the day presently. We shall through the raising of pertinent questions proffer answers gotten by the inspiration and revelation of the Holy Spirit, which would throw some shade of light on the happenings in the garden at that time.

THE FEMALE IS DIFFERENT FROM THE WOMAN

QN: Why is the Woman an enigma or mystery? Have you ever wondered why the Woman was made outside the specific seven (7) day period of God's creation and making of the hosts of the heavens and earth? Was she an afterthought by God? How come the Woman was made way after God had finished and ended His work of creation?

Gen 1:27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; <u>male and female created he them</u>. **Vr. 28** And God blessed them

Gen 5:1 In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God made he him; **Vr. 2** Male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created.

So at the creation, spiritually, Adam was created as a spirit, having the female specie also on the inside of him. Adam was not created as male only but as male and female combined as one spiritually. After the spiritual creation of Adam, the Bible said:

Gen 1:31 And God saw every thing that he had made and behold, it was very good.

Gen 2:1 Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. Vr. 2 And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made: and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made. Vr. 3 And God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made. Vr. 5 And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth and there was not a man to till the ground. Vr. 7 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. Vr. 8 And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed. Vr. 15 And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it. Vr. 16 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: Vr. 17 But of the tree of knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

In all the narration above, the woman was not yet formed nor made, but the female was already created. God had ended his work which he had created and made. He beheld everything he had made with man inclusive and said it was <u>very good</u> without the woman as it were. The man was formed by God and placed in the garden for the purpose of tilling the ground, dressing and keeping the garden, overseeing/dominating over all the living things in it, be fruitful and multiply and have fellowship with God without any mention of woman.

Qn: Why was not the woman captured in the whole of this original creation as at this time? And in God's outlined plan for man as it were?

Ans: Right from the beginning of even the angelic creation, before the creation of man, the woman was not featured. Among the angels of God and the hosts of heaven there is no mention of the woman sex rather we hear of man, sons of God, heavenly creatures and beasts, trees, host of heavens, etc. And the angels as men in heaven were fruitful and multiplied filling the heavens and dominating the hosts of heaven as it were. In similar manner, man was created and was meant to operate in the earth and over the entire host therein spiritually (Gen 2:1). Angels unlike man though were not formed from the dust of the ground, thereby making man a little lower than the angels but both are the workmanship of God-Ps 8:4-6

Angels are men in heaven while Adam was man on earth. Whether in heaven or on earth from inception it was man and no woman.

God created the female, but made the Woman. Gen 1:27

The female was created as a spirit but the Woman was made as flesh and bone. Gen 2:22,23

The female was created strong, but the Woman was brought forth weak. The female was created on the 6th day of creation, but the Woman was made way outside the 7 days of the creation period of God. **Gen 1:31**

WHO TOLD ADAM THAT HE WAS ALONE?

Adam having begun in the Spirit, afterwards sought to be made perfect by the flesh as it were-Gal 3:3. How? Adam started feeling alone (which he never felt before), his Mtt 6:16 sad countenance and a disfigured face and his fellowship with God every evening was not sufficient for him any longer after having named and seen the animals in pairs. He began to walk by sight - 2 Cor. 5:7 "For we walk by faith, not by sight". Someone or something told Adam that he was not complete contrary to Col 2:10 "And ye are complete in him" resulting in the seeking episode of Gen 2:20- "but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him". Adam had begun to seek without God's prompting, so he could not find as it were. Jam 4:2 "Ye lust, and have not:...because ye ask not". Adam was desirous, seeking amongst the animals without asking God at the onset. Mtt 7:7,8. And God having seen Adam's countenance not being as before said in Gen 2:18 "And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone: I will make him an help meet for him".

Qn: Who told the man that he was alone? Who told him that he needed a help? Because it was not God that did.

Ans: It is the same Being that told them and made them to realize that they were naked that did, the serpent-Gen 3:11 "And he said Who told thee that thou wast naked?" Vr. 13 "And the woman said, The <u>serpent</u> beguiled me, and I did eat".

The same way that Satan ministered falsely to the 1st Adam stirring up the feelings of loneliness/abandonment in him, so also he did to the last Adam while he was alone in the wilderness (Mtt 4:1,2) and subsequently too during the course of his earthly ministerial work, but the result was different- Jn 16:32 "Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me". Also, Jn 8:29 "And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; Why? For I do always those things that please him".

The 1st Adam could have said the same thing to the Devil in the garden but he did not.

The 2nd Adam used to even crave for personal fellowship with the Father even as the 1st Adam did at the beginning- **Gen 3:8** "And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day:"; **Mtt 14:23** "And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone".

The statement of **Gen 2:18** was as a result of **Gen 2:20** which falls under the permissive will of God and not the perfect will of God as captured in **Gen 1:27,31; Gen 2:1-3**.

When a man is fully occupied having sweet fellowship with the Lord and doing those things that please Him, being in the Spirit always such cannot be alone nor feel lonely- Mtt 4:11; Jn 1:51. It is only when your attention is diverted from God by the devil unto contrary emotions and feelings that loneliness can come. Heb 12:1,2.

THE WOMAN WAS NOT MADE HEADLESS

The Woman is different from the wife. A wife is a transformed woman who is subject to a man as her husband, her head, the power over her. God made a woman but brought a wife unto Adam. As just a woman she shall always rebel against the authority of the man over her even as the devil rebels against the authority of God; but for a wife it is not so; even as Christ submits to the authority of God so does the wife to that of her husband.

The woman was different from Eve. How? As a Woman she caused Adam to fall but as Eve she was a wife and a mother. Adam had to change her name from Woman to Eve to reflect this. **Gen. 2:23; Gen. 3:20** As a Woman she did not submit to the headship of Adam but as Eve she did. God had to explicitly defined her role in relationship with the man without any ambiguity. **Gen. 3:16, 12**

God did not make the Woman without a head; I Tim 2:13 "Adam was first formed before Eve". So Adam was meant to be a cover for the Woman as his Wife. So Eve was not to be just a mere woman without a cover. From the beginning it is a wife that God intended for Adam not just a woman. A wife is an help meet for the man not a woman.

- I Cor 11:9 Neither was the man created for the woman; but the woman for the man.
- Verse 8- For the man is not of the woman; but the woman of the man.
- **Verse 7-** For a man..., for a smuch as he is the image and glory of God: but the woman is the glory of the man.
- Verse 3- and the head of the woman is the man.

Every Woman is meant to have a head over her to whom she submits to whether she be single/unmarried as a virgin or married. Why? Because as only a woman she is but a body only but as a wife she has a head. Therefore as an unmarried chaste virgin(single woman), she is either spiritually married to Christ unto righteousness or to Satan by being in sin. While as a married woman, apart from first being found in either of the above spiritual marriage, she is in addition also married physically to either a godly man or an ungodly man. I Cor 7:34; Rom 7:1-4

In **Jn 4:14-26** when the Samaritan woman at the well requested for the gift of God, the living water, from Christ, he demanded that she produce her cover, the power over her first before he could oblige her. She was unable to produce a physical husband because she was living in sin but she had a spiritual head which was Satan and not Christ as it were. She needed to be delivered and saved first. You do not give your holy things to dogs. **Mtt 15:26**; **Mtt 7:6**

A woman was made to be covered whether spiritually or/and physically. She was not meant to be uncovered. Every woman that seeketh to be uncovered after having received a godly cover is a shame and contentious rebelling against the ordinance of God even as Satan is presently. Rom 13:1 "Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. Vr. 2 Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God; and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation". Therefore it is expected that the wife be subject to her own husband, having a quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God is of great price but this is not the case for a wife as a mere woman, she rebels against the authority of her husband at every turn; seeking separation to her own detriment before God, whom she shall appear before as a covenant breaker on the judgement day if she separates in marriage eventually. Rom. 1:31

The Woman was made as a help meet for the Man meaning that the woman was made to be a wife in relationship with Adam from start and not a mere independent woman (or a mate/an equal to the man) or one craving independence from the man. A woman was made to have a man as a head over her even as the man was made to have a head over him that is Christ. I Cor 11:3. The Woman was made to be dependent on the Man, who was in the garden before her to show her the ropes and the way round about it as it were. But a mere woman finds it hard to submit to the man rather it is the wife that submits readily and seamlessly. The Woman seeks independence from the man whether in marriage or outside marriage, but not a true wife.

The head loves while the body submits. Any woman without a man over her as a head whether it be her father, male guardian, relation or husband is a headless body and without a cover. This therefore is tangent to God's ordination. Such a woman is vainly puffed up by her fleshly mind if she thinks she has no head, whether seen and/or unseen over her she is deceiving herself as it were, for so was the Woman beguiled from the beginning. Colo. 2:18,19; Jam 2:26; 2 Cor. 11:3

Whenever a woman is to be given out in marriage as a wife, then the head over her must be identified, if such head was not explicitly known before to all; for necessarily a man must give her out in marriage in order that an exchange of headship over her may take place. The father or his male representative has to hand over the baton of headship to another man called her husband from thence. **Num 30:1-16; Deu 22:13-21**

WHY WOMAN?

Spiritually/divinely speaking a man does not need a woman to reproduce, nor does a woman need a man to do same, all that is needed is the power of God, His Word, at work. How? Mtt 8:8 "but speak the word only"; Jn 1:12 "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: Vr. 13 Which were born (not carnally), not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but (spiritually) of God". The last Adam demonstrated that for us, for he never married yet he produced children (of which we are today) without knowing a woman- Gal 3:26 "For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus". God demonstrated also through the vessel Virgin Mary that He can bring forth a child without her knowing a man - Lk 1:34,35,37- "For with God nothing shall be impossible".

The spiritual perfect will of God for Adam was to be divine in nature on earth, even as the angels are divine in heaven; not for producing fleshly children through a woman but rather spiritual ones through Christ. That is what the Great Commission mandate of Christ given to us causes us to do even today; we populate the earth with the spiritual children of God therewith and we are all gathered together as the household of God called the Church of Christ on the earth as it were. **Rom 8:19-21; Eph 2:19-22**

Mtt 22:29 Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God. Vr. 30 For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels of God in heaven. Lk 20:34 The children of this world marry and are given in marriage:

It was out of the permissive will of God and not His perfect will that He obliged Adam's desire and made woman, but as a wife, to be with him and help him meet his fleshly craving, while yet trying to accomplish the divine mandate given to him from the time he was formed out of the dust of the ground and placed in the garden. This permissive arrangement brought about by spiritual warfare within him as it were, of which Adam woefully lost the battle in the garden, unlike the last Adam's resistance and victory over the Devil in the wilderness. Gal 5:16,17

But by reason of the fall, Adam and Eve became earthy and carnal in nature and were cast out of the spiritual grounds of the garden as it were. So the reason for their being together became carnal rather than spiritual. The carnal reason then came into force as they entered the cursed carnal world outside the garden. **Gen 4:1-2;** Lk 20:34; Mtt 19:2,8

Qn: What was the carnal reason for Adam and Eve becoming husband and wife? for sensual companionship that is to result in conception and fleshly procreation. This was but a shadow of the real thing that God had originally intended for Adam in **Gen 1:26-30**. But by the victory of Christ on the cross over sin and Satan, we have been co-opted into carrying out the image version of the real thing (which is still to come) while we are yet on the earth and that is our making of as many as believe (or giving birth to sons by Christ), the children of God by the Word and Spirit of Christ. **Jam 1:18; Jn 1:11-13; Jn 3:5**

Gal. 4:19 My little children of whom I travail in birth again until Christ be formed in you.

Gen 3:16 Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee. Vr. 20 And Adam called his wife's name Eve; because she was the mother of all living.

But before the fall when they were in the garden, Adam did not know the Woman sexually rather **Gen 2:25** "And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed". But when they transgressed the

story changed **Gen 3:7** "And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked;" and they had to be ejected out of the garden before they defiled it. **Gen 4:1** "And Adam knew Eve his wife: and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said I have gotten a man from the LORD".

Sex is a product of the fall and a manifestation of Man's carnal nature at play like the animals too. Similarly, the fallen angels, cast out of heaven, reduced to carnality entered the daughters of men on earth in order to pollute the seed of the woman. **Gen 6:1-5**. By reason of Man's fall also, cast out of the garden, the seed that Adam began to produce with Eve was ungodly, no longer in the image and likeness of God exactly, but that of sinful Adam- **Gen 5:3** and that is why Cain could easily kill his brother at the slightest provocation and slyly too.

The Woman is a form of man that has a womb and other bodily parts that are suitably meant for satisfying the desire of the man and also able to bear and rear up children thereby - naturally speaking anyway. Rom 1:27 "And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman".

Qn: Why and how are women taken as wives? Gen 6:1 "And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them. Vr. 2 That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose. Vr. 4 There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them".

No woman or wife can truly satisfy a man whether in the flesh or otherwise, for such satisfaction is always temporal. The lusts of the flesh are insatiable; satisfaction and fulfillment is found only in the Spirit. Money, sex, material acquisitions, food and the likes cannot satisfy a man completely. There is an emptiness in the man that only the Spirit can satisfy which carnal things cannot. Be not deceived or made to think otherwise as many are today. Colo 2:10; Jn 16:32; Prov 27:20; Lk 12:15

WOMAN IS THE FLESH CUM BODY OF THE MAN

I Cor 11:3- and the head of the woman is the man.

Eph 5:28- So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself. How?

Verse 29- For <u>no man ever yet hated his own flesh</u>; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the church.

STATEMENT: So the woman is likened unto the body, the flesh of the man, even as the church is the body of Christ.

Even Adam declared so at seeing the Woman the very first time:

Gen 2:23- And Adam said, this is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of man.

STATEMENT: Man was formed out of the dust of the ground as even the trees and the beasts of the field, the fowls of the air except for the Woman, she was taken out of the already made man. The Woman proceedeth

forth from the Man- the Woman was made mainly for the Man. Why? In order to satisfy his carnal desire in a godly acceptable context as a wife and not in sin as a mere woman - Gen 2:7,9,19; Gen 3:16; I Cor 7:2-5; I Cor 6:15,16

The woman is the carnal aspect of the man made manifest bodily. The woman is the spiritual female clothed with flesh and bones in order to become physical. In other words, the woman is the physical manifestation of the spiritual female that was in the man right from creation.

Everything that Adam needed to accomplish the purpose for which he was created by God from the beginning was already in him spiritually, but unfortunately, he was made to think otherwise and desired for it to come out so that he can see and feel it instead physically- the bone of his bones, and flesh of his flesh- that is not how we ought to walk with God- Jn 20:27-29; 2 Cor 5:7

But as long as the carnal aspect of man was kept inside of him and in-operative man could not sin, until it was brought out. Mtt 26:41 "Watch and pray that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak". But Adam desired for the flesh to come out, the weaker portion of him. I Pet 3:7 "Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel". God did not create anything weak but instead a weak thing was made. How? There is no weakness in God from whom the Man was created but Man manifested a weakness and by God's permissive will, the weakness in Man was brought out, that is the Woman.

And after the woman was brought out of man, the devil went for the jugular, the vulnerable aspect of the man made manifest bodily and he got her to disobey the commandment of God which Adam had managed to keep up until then. The Woman got the man to do what Satan could not get him to do directly; she got her husband to join her in eating of the forbidden fruit. The Woman delivered another gospel to Adam and Adam bought into it. **Gen 3:12,13**

By reason of the fleshly nature of the Woman, she is more carnally minded than the Man and her affections are generally set on things beneath rather than on things above. She is very much controlled, influenced and guided by her emotions and feelings. Note that feeling is the voice of the flesh as it were. Also Satan has been given the flesh as food by God (Gen 3:14) and that is why the women folks are more susceptible to the beguilement of the enemy. Gen 3:13 "And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat". 2 Tim 3:6; I Pet 3:3; 2 Cor. 11:3. As ye walk after flesh, the nature of Satan is made manifest whether it be in a man or a woman in particular, such as seduction, subtlety, slyness, envying, murders, lying, beguilement and the likes. The Woman whenever she is being used by Satan (as like with Eve/Delilah) against a Man operates these traits well and more. Jud 16:15-19

THE WOMAN BROUGHT ABOUT SEPARATION

When God brought the woman that He had made to Adam He waited to see how Adam would receive her and call her, unfortunately Adam received her as a mere woman, a mate and not as a wife as God had intended for him (**Gen 2:22,23**). That showed his own lustful desire and not actually God's own will for him. This confirmed the separation between God and Adam that had gradually begun with the loneliness saga, which would later translate into his cleaving to his wife and disengaging from his unalloyed fellowship with God.

Gen 3:7,8; I Cor 7:32,33,35 The Woman's coming was a distraction to the previously undivided fellowship that Adam used to have with God. In the garden of Eden, Adam called her at first sight Woman, after which she behaved like the Woman she was and caused him to fall. He later realizing his mistake renamed her properly as Eve, a wife and a mother but the harm had already been done. Gen. 2:23; Gen 3:20

STATEMENT: Whenever a man seeks to do his own will contrary to the will of God a separation occurs, fortunately the last Adam was fully aware of this and resisted the temptation of having his own will done instead of God's - Mtt 6:10; Lk 22:42. God prophesied about the separation from Adam even before it happened because he is the God that maketh known the end even from the beginning. How?

Gen 2:24 "Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto <u>his wife</u>" (not his woman): [Adam saw a mere woman-Vr. 23, but God saw a wife-Vr. 24]

Gen 3:12 And the man said, <u>The woman</u> whom thou gavest to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat. **Vr. 17** And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of <u>thy wife</u> (rather than the voice of God) and had eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it:".

By reason of Adam relating with Eve as a woman not as a wife he was faced with a dilemma of whose voice he was to hearken unto, that of his woman or that of God. Till today men are usually put in that same dilemma by wives that are mere women and they fall even as Adam fell by choosing to hearken unto their voice rather than that of God. Lk. 14:26; Lk. 16:13; Mtt 10:36; Micah 7:5-6

Till today, women are still veritable tools for unlocking the door to the heart of a man either to allow sin to come in and occupy or as a wife to allow righteousness to reign within him. The Woman shall do the man evil while the wife shall do him good. So the man has to relate with the woman with discernment of spirits. He can escape her subtlety of bringing evil/sin upon him, if he walks conscious of the truth always, walking with her in knowledge, being wise, and led by the Spirit accordingly (**Rom 8:14**) rather than by the flesh cum emotions as she is led by majorly. If not, the very same thing that happened to the 1st Adam would happen to him as it is still happening today whether in marriage or outside of marriage.

The fastest and surest way to bring down an undiscerning husband is through the wife as a mere woman. Seek for a godly wife (a God fearing woman as a wife), rather than for a mere woman as a life companion if you want to make heaven. Ignorance is a destroyer as it were.

I Pet 3:7; Mtt 10:36; Micah 7:5; Gen 3:12,17

Eccl 7:26 And I find more bitter than death the woman, whose heart is snares and nets, and her hands as bands: whoso pleaseth God shall escape from her; but the sinner shall be taken by her.

Prov 18:22 Whoso findeth <u>a wife</u> (not a mere woman) findeth a good thing, and obtaineth favour of the LORD.

Prov. 31:12 She will do him good and not evil all the days of her life.

THE WOMAN AS A MURDERER

The original creation of man as the image and likeness of God was spiritual, as male and female in one Man called Adam, not as man and wife in two distinct Beings called man and woman or husband and wife. God brought Adam into the garden to be tempted by the Devil even as the last Adam was led by the Spirit into the wilderness for the same purpose to be tested and proven, before he can qualify to commence the core earthly divine mandate ordained for him- Mtt 4:1,2.

Adam was carnally ministered unto by Satan with the evil arrow of loneliness and he bought the lonely feeling as it were, resulting in him seeking for someone he did not know as of yet. God eventually brought forth that someone, a woman; though he had not yet sinned by asking for her (because he had not yet disobeyed God's specific commandment to him) I Cor 7:28 "But and if thou marry, thou hast not sinned: and if a virgin marry, she hath not sinned", but by this his desire, then we had at play a similitude of Gen 4:7 " if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire"; For when the Woman arrived and was subsequently tempted also by Satan without Adam intervening. Adam did not do well by not stopping that Satanic interaction, so sin came in and had its desire over him and he fell - I Tim 2:14 "And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression". 1Cor. 7:28b "Nevertheless such shall have trouble in the flesh: but I spare you".

Adam asked for trouble when he desired a woman without God's prompting. The Woman rose up against Adam her husband and slew him as it were, even as Cain did against Abel his brother. Cain's own slaying was physical, but the Woman's own was spiritual and far more devastating, affecting all mankind thereafter. **Gen 4:6-8**

Every man that marries a mere woman instead of a true wife is liable to be slain one time or the other by that woman before the end of that marriage. Be warned.

The Woman even as used by Satan was a murderer from the beginning and abode not in the truth rather she spoke a lie to Adam even as a liar. **Jn.8:44**.

The Woman takes life or kills while the wife gives life as a mother. It is by the Woman that offence came and that is why she is odious and taketh offence very easily, but it is by the seed of the woman (wife) that grace came.

Adam was lured into desiring for a woman not by God but the serpent as it were. And God granted him his desire, that is why woman was not made for God but for the man. Without the man desiring for her there would have been no woman even as God had originally intended. At the end also as it was in the beginning there would be no woman again but only the man.

WOMAN AS A MEANS OF DEFILEMENT

Throughout the Bible, whenever a man is expected to sanctify, cleanse himself in preparation to meet with the Lord, he is enjoined to stay/keep away from women for some couple of days. Why? Because the spirit is defiled by the flesh and its lust thereof. **Gal 5:16,17**

Gal 6:8- For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption.

When you want to fellowship unhindered in the Spirit then you have to leave off sowing to the flesh in sexual intercourse with a woman. Even worldly athletes' are mindful to keep away from women during intense competitions, talk less of soldiers in the warfront (2 Sam 11:11). It is called being temperate in order to attain mastery and win the prize at the end. I Cor 9:25-27

I Cor 7:5 Defraud ye not one the other, except it be with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency.

1 Sam 21:4-6- Vr. 5- of a truth women have been kept from us about these three days since I came.

Exo 19:10,11- Be ready against the third day come not at you wives.

Lev 15:18 The woman also with whom man shall lie with seed of copulation, they shall both bathe themselves in water, and be unclean until the even.

Rev 14:4- these are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins.

Sexual intercourse is a carnal interaction that is only allowed by God in marriage as it were but outside of marriage it becomes a sin. But all the same it is a byproduct of the fall and a remainder of the carnal nature of man at play. The woman was made to satisfy this urge in a man but unfortunately uses it devilishly at times as a weapon to enter the man as she desires whether for good or for evil; this ought not to be so for the godly wife but for a mere woman. I Cor 7:4

STATEMENT: But every woman that is truly in Christ is meant no longer to operate on strictly the carnal level but to be spiritual also as a new man in living. **I Pet 3:7** "giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and <u>as being heirs together of the grace of life;</u>". The man and the woman in Christ are both heirs of God spiritually speaking.

I Pet 3:3-5- Wives are encouraged not to be so carnal in their adornment but to put on the spiritual adornment that of a meek and quiet spirit that yields the result of holiness, submission and humility unto their head.

I Cor 7:34 The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit:

A woman is a dangerous manipulative tool in the hands of the devil. She needs to be made a wife of/by Christ in order for her to escape the grasp of the enemy and be used to bring forth life and peace rather than turmoil and death upon the man. By the Spirit of Christ she can overcome the continual prodding of her flesh by the enemy for death purposes.

The devil is wroth with woman till today and will use her by all means to continually wage war against the remnant of the seed of the woman, the man, even as he could not devour the man child at birth, who was caught up unto God, for he knoweth that his time is short. **Rev. 12:4,5,12,17; Isa. 49:15**

THE SEED OF THE WOMAN BROUGHT ABOUT RECONCILIATION

The 1st Woman, was used by Satan to bring about the fall of the 1st Adam, but God used virgin Mary the 2nd Woman to bring forth the 2nd Adam even for the defeat of Satan eternally as it were. Woman that was used by Satan to bring about the fall of man, God also used as a wife to bring about Man's rescue and restoration again. God had prophesied it even from the very beginning. When?

The LORD God, had made provision for His reconciliation with man after the separation, through the <u>one flesh</u> concept, which is the body of his Son, Jesus Christ, the seed of the woman, the holy, virtuous woman, the godly wife as it were. **Gen 2:24** ":and they shall be one flesh". **Rom 12:5; I Cor. 6:16,17; I Cor. 10:17; I Pet 3:5**. Man and wife becoming one flesh is truly possible only in Christ and not without Christ.

Eph 2: 16 And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby.

The fall of man- Gen 2:24 "Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife:".

Then followed by the Reconciliation provision- Gen 2:24 "and they shall be one flesh" Gal 4:4 "But when the fullness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, Vr. 5 To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons". 2 Cor 5:19 ".... That God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself".

Defeat of Satan- **Gen 3:15** "And I will put enmity between thee and the woman and between thy seed and her seed, it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel".

By the reconciliation of Man to God through the seed of the Woman, the scripture is fulfilled that saith **Rom 8:28** "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose".

WOMAN IS FOR THE EARTH AND NOT FOR HEAVEN

The woman was not created but she was made it was the female that was created and shall be there in Heaven in the man. The woman, as her nature is now, was made strictly for operating in the earthly realm as the body of Man, which body will need to be put off at the point of translation into the heavenly realms at the 1st Resurrection cum Rapture event so that the spirit will take over. As the Man is to return back to the dust of the ground from whence he was taken at birth, so also shall the Woman return back to the Man out of whom she was taken too- this is yet a mystery. **Gen. 3:19;Gen. 2:23**

There are no women gender in heaven, what we have are Men and sons of God. Women are called daughters of men, wives and mothers here on earth and those roles expire here on earth at the end of time because they are tied to the earthy man. There are no daughters of God nor wives or mothers in heaven because there is no marrying of woman or giving in marriage of woman there for the heavenly spiritual man has no need for such in heaven- Mtt 22:30. In heaven, we all shall be called "Sons of God" thereby having no gender distinction again but one gender-Man.

The woman was made mainly for man's pleasure here on earth and not for heavenly reasons. In heaven every creature or being there is created and made for God's pleasure strictly and Woman is not inclusive. **Rev. 4:11;** 1Cor. 15:35-58

Therefore do not allow yourself to play these feminine roles/titles erroneously as a mere woman, thereby truncating your journey to heaven. It would not be worthy it. Therefore behave yourself as a wife in a godly manner while playing in any of these roles here on earth in order to guarantee your access to heaven on the last day. A Woman feels frustrated if she is unable to fulfil her role for the man here on earth as it were. She is meant to bring him pleasure as much as can be possible as a wife cum mother and not as a mere woman.

CONCLUSION

Every woman that willingly choose to be ignorant of the aforementioned things deceiveth herself in rejecting and resisting the truths therein. She shall thereby find herself playing right into the hands of the Devil again as a tool of destruction of man as it was from the beginning in the garden, contrary to the will of God for restoration of man unto Himself and the defeat of Satan through the seed of the woman in these last days.

Man as originally created as a spirit (male and female in one) shall continue in the world to come without woman, just like the angels of God in heaven.

Mtt 22:30, Mk. 10: 6

As it was in the very beginning so shall it be at the very end. Gen. 5:1,2

May the Lord grant you the opening of your eyes of understanding to grasp the revealed mystery contained herein, that you live not ignorant unto the truncation of your calling in Christ Jesus as a woman or as a man in relationship with the woman in Jesus name. Amen.
