

THE MYSTERY OF MALE AND FEMALE CREATION

INTRODUCTION

The book called the Bible is one of the most read books in the world and understandably is one of the most misunderstood and misinterpreted one as well. This is because of the fact that the contents thereof are divinely coded. And this requires spiritual insights that come by revelations that God gives to a few to unravel or decode the letters thereof, by the Spirit of truth which Christ gives in baptism. Many ignore this truth to their peril. **I Cor 2:1-16**

The Bible is a book containing mysteries from Genesis to Revelation that without your unveiling and having the spiritual knowledge of the foundations thereof will cause you to walk in error of understanding throughout the rest of its contents as it were. **Hosea 4:6-7**

In this literature, we shall be unraveling the mystery of the creation of Male and Female by God from the beginning. It is a mystery to many today due to the misconstruing of the Scripture concerning it by the Church as a business organization (CAO), and which error many generally accept as true. And also the holding unto by many of the worldly dictionary definition of male and female that was not so at the beginning biblical speaking from the time of creation. This has caused many to veer into grave error in the understanding of the creation by God of the most important “creature” in the Bible, which is Man. **Gen 1:26-27**

The Ministers of the people (MOP) of the CAO misconstrue the male and female creation of Man only by God on the sixth (6th) day to mean creation of Man and Woman instead. Even some modern day Bible versions now boldly translate it erroneously as such. By this many are made to believe a lie in the place of the spiritual truth of God and His Christ, walking by the wisdom of men rather than by that of God. We shall seek to unravel this mystery by being mindful to hear Christ our Lord and Master in his doctrine rather than men.

MALE AND FEMALE IS OF THE CREATION OF THE SPIRIT OF MAN

There are some foundational spiritual truths pertaining to “create, form and make” concepts that the reader need to know in order to flow in the understanding of the Genesis creation story. We therefore highly recommend your reading our literature titled “Create-Form-Make Divine Concept” for background insights required in understanding this literature.

Gen 1: 26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: **Vr.27** So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

Male and female is the first Man called Adam created as a spirit without a body that comprised of flesh and bone as of then. **Gen 5:1-2**

Gen 2: 5 And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and there was not a man to till the ground [*because no body had yet been formed to house this spirit of man that had already been created*].

Lk 24:36-43 (Vr.37) But they were terrified and affrighted, and supposed that they had seen a spirit. **Vr.39** Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have.

When Man called Adam was created as male and female he was created as a spirit without a body. Adam as it were was born of God being born of the Spirit as spirit. God is a Spirit and in His image and likeness He created Adam, male and female in spirit and in truth. Adam was not born of flesh and therefore did not have body at this time, but was as the wind, a spirit.

Jn 3: 6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. **Vr.8** The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

Jn 4: 23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. **Vr.24** God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

Subsequently, God formed a body comprising of flesh and bone to house Adam's already created spirit. This body was given the breath of life by God and the tripartite Man then became a living soul. This body of man was of angelic, celestial in nature being of flesh and bone without blood, of the glory of God. It was a glorious body. **I Cor 11:7; Phil 3:21; 2 Cor 5:1-4**

Gen 2: 7 And the LORD God formed [*a body for the spirit of*] man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. **Vr.8** And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed [*now having body, spirit and soul*]. **Vr.15** And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it.

I Cor 15: 38 But God giveth it a body as it hath pleased him, and to every seed his own body.

When as spirit only, male and female, man could not till the ground, but as a living soul he could as it were, having been given a body.

MALE AND FEMALE DOES NOT MEAN MAN AND WOMAN

It is an error in interpretation of the creation of Man as male and female to mean the creation of Man and Woman. This is a common error found amongst Bible readers that is based on presumption/assumption due to CAO indoctrination that is of flesh and blood thinking. God speaks spiritually, while men hear carnally.

Gen 1: 26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: **Vr.27** So God created man [*not woman*] in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them [*not as Man and Woman*]. **Vr.31** And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

On the sixth day of creation, Man alone was created and not Woman. God rested on the seventh day having finished all of His creations without Woman.

Gen 2: 1 Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. **Vr.2** And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made. **Vr.3** And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made. **Vr.8** And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed.

Gen 5: 1 This is the book of the generations of Adam. In the day that God created man, in the likeness of God [*a Spirit*] made he him [*spirit*]; **Vr.2** Male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created [*without a body but as spirit*].

Christ in his doctrine also told us how it was at the beginning.

Mk 10: 6 But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female [*and called them Adam, not Adam and Eve as per twain*].

Male and female was created as one spirit as we have opined, not two spirits. Subsequently one flesh cum body was formed from the dust of the ground to house this one spirit. The one flesh was given the breath of life in order for the Man to become a living soul. Male and female became one Man having one body, one spirit, and one soul, while Man and Woman are twain, having two separate bodies, two souls and two spirits as distinct individual entities.

Male and female at the beginning was one entity, while Man and Woman are two distinct entities or beings. Male and female was called Adam as one, not Adam and Eve as twain.

THE COMING FORTH OF THE WOMAN

Throughout the seven (7) day creation and rest of God, no Woman was created except Man. When God formed Man with a body and put him in the Garden that He had planted eastward in Eden, there was still no Woman in existence. Adam was still a living soul that was male and female in a body. **Gen 2:5-15**

It was eventually in the garden of Eden that God took a rib from the flesh and bone of the formed Adam to make a Woman. Adam was created from the Spirit by the Word of God as spirit at the beginning, but not so the Woman. The Woman was taken out of the rib of the formed Adam and not out of Spirit. As it were, Adam was born of the Spirit, while the Woman was born of the flesh at the beginning. **Jn 3:6; Jn 6:63**

I Tim 2: 13 For Adam was first formed, then Eve.

Gen 2:20-22 (Vr.21 And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; **Vr.22** And the rib [*not the spirit*], which the LORD God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man.

God did not take the female out of the “male and female” composed spirit of Adam as many erroneously deduce. Rather God took a rib out of the flesh and bone of Adam instead in order to make the Woman, meaning that Man still had male and female in him.

Gen 2: 23 And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man.

This was when we now had Woman with Man in celestial existence, and not when God created Man alone as male and female. Man and Woman is twain, that is, two (2) flesh, two (2) spirits and two (2) souls that are distinct and separate from each other, unlike male and female at the beginning of creation of Man.

It is at the time of sex or copulation between the Man and the Woman as humans that they are said to be “one flesh” though still two (2) spirits and two (2) souls at such times. Sex is only a carnal joining or coming together of two flesh to be one flesh, and not a spiritual joining as the CAO try to make it out to be. This became possible only after the fall and the eviction of the Man and Woman from Eden into the world as it were. **Gen 4:1-2; Gen 3:16,20**

Mk 10: 6 But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female [*one spirit called Man*]. **Vr.7** For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and cleave to his wife; **Vr.8** And they twain shall be one flesh: so then they are no more twain, but one flesh [*during copulation*].

Gen 2: 24 Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

SCIENTIFIC SUPPORT OF MALE AND FEMALE IN MAN

Modern day science has provided proof of the physical semblance of the spiritual reality that God put in place at the creation of Man as male and female in the beginning, even as Christ our Lord affirmed.

Mtt 19: 4 And he answered and said unto them, Have ye not read, that he which made them at the beginning made them male and female, **Vr.8** He saith unto them, Moses because of the hardness of your hearts suffered you to put away your wives: but from the beginning it was not so.

Scientists have made us to know biologically, that humans have 22 pairs of chromosomes plus the two sex chromosomes – XX in women and XY in men for a total of 46. A chromosome is a strand of DNA that is encoded with genes found in the cell nucleus of humans.

So the man has both male (Y) and female (X) chromosomes in him, unlike the woman that has a pair only of female (XX) chromosomes. A man is male and female, while a woman is female and female instead. Therefore, it is from the Man's chromosome that the sex of the baby that a woman conceives is determined. How? by reason of the type of his sex chromosome (X or Y) that fertilizes the woman's ovary (X) at copulation, when they come together as one flesh in sexual intercourse as it were.

It is as human beings that the worldly dictionary defines or differentiates the Man as the "male sex" and the Woman as the "female sex", but before the world began it was not so at the very beginning biblically nor is it so amongst the angels in the heavenly places.

MAN AS MALE AND FEMALE IS LIKENED UNTO A FRUITFUL TREE

Man, generally is likened unto as a fruitful tree throughout in the Bible in order to reflect his original creation of having male and female in him. God intended the Man, Adam that He created in His image and likeness to reproduce his kind as trees do asexually and not as animals

do sexually. It was after the fall that sinful man was downgraded to be producing sexually with the woman in the world. Trees generally have both male and female reproductive units in themselves as it were. **Hebr 2:6-7,14**

Gen 1: 11 And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so. **Vr.12** And the earth brought forth grass, and herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed was in itself, after his kind: and God saw that it was good. **Vr.26** And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: **Vr.27** So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. **Vr.28** And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply [*as the tree does*], and replenish the earth, **Vr.31** And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good.

Isa 61:1-3 (Vr.3 To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.

Jer 17:5-8 (Vr.6 For he shall be like the heath in the desert, and shall not see when good cometh; **Vr.8** For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green [*male "he" and female "her" in one*]; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

Ps 1:1-3 (Vr.1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. **Vr.3** And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

Ps 52: 8 But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God:

Our Master Christ also in his doctrines likened Man to a seed, and a fruit bearing tree, plant and branch as it were. **Mtt 15:12-14; Mtt 7:15-20; Mtt 13:24-26; Jn 12:24; Mtt 3:7-10**

Jn 15:1-8 (Vr.1 I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. **Vr.2** Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit. **Vr.4** Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me. **Vr.5** I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing. **Vr.8** Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.

Lk 13:6-10 (Vr.6 He spake also this parable; A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came and sought fruit thereon, and found none. **Vr.7** Then said he unto the dresser of his vineyard, Behold, these three years I come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and find none: cut it down; why cumbereth it the ground? **Vr.8** And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung it: **Vr.9** And if it bear fruit, well: and if not, then after that thou shalt cut it down.

Mtt 12: 33 Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit. **Vr.34** O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. **Vr.35** A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.

This was how Adam was created at the beginning good like a fruit bearing tree, being male and female in spirit. He was to be fruitful and multiply on the earth in such a manner as it were. Adam produced the Woman before the fall as a tree, but after the fall Woman began to produce humans instead as animals do. It was not so from the beginning. **I Cor. 11:8-12**

Adam as a living soul was as a seed that God put to death figuratively by causing a deep sleep to fall on him before he could produce fruit in the form of Woman. Before then he was abiding alone, but God through this process gave him a woman to be with him. **Gen 2:21-22; Gen 3:12**

Jn 12: 24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

Gen 2: 18 And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.

CONCLUSION

The worldly dictionary defines male and female as two distinct flesh (Man and Woman), while at creation God create male and female as one spirit. Many cling tenaciously unto the knowledge of the former to their being kept ignorant of the latter perpetually.

A true knowledge of the mystery of male and female is pertinent to the foundational understanding of the nature of Man at creation, and how it is that God formed him to operate on the heaven and earth realm that He created and made from the beginning. This shall be the same nature that man being human presently shall be returned to as from the last day, a nature that is celestial and not terrestrial any longer. **I Cor 15:35-54; I Cor 11:7; Phil 3:21; 2 Cor 5:1-4; Lk 20:35-36**

Unfortunately, it is not given to those that think as flesh and blood being carnally minded to know the mystery of male and female, but unto those that are spiritually minded having the Spirit of Christ dwelling and witnessing in them as it were. Flesh and blood revelation cannot bring you to this spiritual understanding rather such shall be hid from you, even as it is the case with the CAO presently. **Mtt 13:9-11; Mtt 16:15-17; 2 Cor 4:2-3**

When you get it wrong from Genesis, you will be in error of understanding overall till Revelation. Be warned. We would recommend to you for further reading our literature titled "The Tripartite Being Called Man" for more insights.

Male and Female is One spirit, while Man and Woman is Two spirits, Two flesh and Two souls. Therefore, male and female does not translate to man and woman in any way, but man only.

May the good Lord by his Spirit of truth give you knowledge in the things written herein, that the eyes of your understanding may be enlightened; that ye may know that which is freely given to us by the Spirit in Jesus name. Amen.
