

WHY THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN?(2)

Christ came preaching concerning the kingdom of heaven; for what reason?

Mtt 4:16 The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up. **Vr.17** From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Why the kingdom of heaven? Without it coming within you, you cannot be born again.

Lk 17:20 And when He was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, He answered them and said, The kingdom of God cometh not with observation: **Vr.21** Neither shall they say, Lo here! or, lo there! for, behold, the kingdom of God is within you.

If the world is within you still, then you cannot be born again nor understand concerning the kingdom of heaven, but only the things concerning the kingdoms of this world instead. Why?

Ecc1 3:11 He hath made every thing beautiful in his time: also He hath set the world in their heart, so that no man can find out the work that God maketh from the beginning to the end.

Mtt 13:10 And the disciples came, and said unto him, Why speakest thou unto them in parables? **Vr.11** He answered and said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given. **Vr.13** Therefore speak I to them in parables: because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not, neither do they understand. **Vr.19** When any one heareth the word of the kingdom, and understandeth it not, then cometh the wicked one, and catcheth away that which was sown in his heart.

The reason why the kingdom of God must compulsorily come unto you?

For you to be born of the Spirit you compulsorily need a spiritual kingdom to be born into or housed. Same goes for you to be born of the flesh you need a terrestrial world to be born into that accommodates flesh. And Christ declared that his kingdom is not of this world. So from the beginning the kingdom that Christ taught about was not meant for human beings, but for spiritual beings. But how was that to be since we are humans asked Nicodemus?

Jn 18:36 Jesus answered, My kingdom is not of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my kingdom not from hence.

Jn 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, He cannot see the kingdom of God. **Vr.4** Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when He is old? can He enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? **Vr.5** Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, He cannot enter into the kingdom of God. **Vr.6** That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. **Vr.7** Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

The kingdom of God can only be accessed by those that become truly born again at the last day; for such are the true children of the kingdom being the children of the resurrection. But for now as redeemed humans, they have the kingdom within them as an image by reason of the Spirit baptism they received. Therefore, such set their affections continually on things that are above where Christ is seated presently.

Colo 3:1 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. **Vr.2** Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. **Vr.3** For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God. **Vr.4** When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.

Those that seeketh for the righteousness of God need His kingdom to come for that to be possible. For this world lieth in wickedness instead and there is none of the children therein that doeth righteousness that is of God.

Rom 3:10 As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: **Vr.11** There is none that understandeth, there is none that seeketh after God. **Vr.12** They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one. **Vr.23** For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

It is in the kingdom of God that His perfect will can be done in righteousness, not in the world. In the world, it is the permissive will of God that subsists as it were.

Mtt 6:9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. **Vr.10** Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. **Vr.33** But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness;

The true kingdom of heaven is for celestial cum heavenly beings, not for natural cum human beings. And that is why flesh and blood cannot enter nor inherit the kingdom of God.

I Cor 15:50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

Christ came preaching the kingdom of heaven because he is the only way through which the redeemed of the LORD can be translated from human beings to spiritual beings, from death to

life, in order to from this world, whether they be dead or alive in him thereof, enter into that kingdom at the last day. And be able to behold the face of the God of that kingdom, our heavenly Father in accordance to His perfect will by Christ Jesus. This is the lively hope that we have in Jesus Christ whom we believe in to bring it to pass as our resurrection and life. Everyone that has this hope in him purifieth himself. **I Jn 3:1-3**

Jn 14:1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. **Vr.6** Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Jn 16:25 These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall shew you plainly of the Father.

Jn 6:40 And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

Jn 11:25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: **Vr.26** And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?

Jn 5:28 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, **Vr.29** And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

I Cor 15:19 If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable. **Vr.47** The first man is of the earth, earthy: the second man is the Lord from heaven. **Vr.48** As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the heavenly, such are they also that are heavenly. **Vr.49** And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly. **Vr.53** For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.
