

BIBLICAL SUMMARIES I

THE PURPOSE FOR THIS NATURAL WORLD AND WHY YOU ARE IN IT

This natural world for humans is a world of sin and death made specifically to accommodate sinners that are offspring of Adam. Adam brought sin and death into the world that he was cast out into as a result of his disobedience to God's commandment in Eden. This present evil world would not have come into existence if Adam had not sinned, but rather he would have inherited the kingdom of heaven with eternal life as his reward for obedience to God instead.

Mtt 25:34; Rom 6:23; Tit 1:1-2; Gen 3:22-24

Rom 5:12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned: **Vr.14** Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come.

But when God created the world He laid the foundations thereof in the blood of the Lamb. Thereby making provision for the redemption of the offspring of Adam to be chosen in Christ Jesus even at His appointed time to come. These are those whose names were to be found in the book of life of the Lamb at the end.

Rev 13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

I Pet 1:18 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; **Vr.19** But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: **Vr.20** Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you,

So at the time determined, God sent His Lamb, Christ the last Adam into the world to put in motion His redemption plan decreed from the foundation of the world. That is, to take away Sin and death through faith from the offspring of fallen Adam. He came to bring righteousness and give life instead to all those that would believe the Truth that he brought through his doctrine.

Lk 1:68 Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people, **Vr.69** And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David; **Vr.70** As he

spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began: **Vr.71** That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us;

Jn 1:17 For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ. **Vr.29** The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

Mtt 1:21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for He shall save his people from their sins.

Jn 10:10 The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. **Vr.11** I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

Christ came as the Way of righteousness that leads to the Truth that gives Life eternal which is of the Father, who art in heaven.

Jn 14:1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. **Vr.6** Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Therefore, Christ came preaching the gospel of the kingdom as the way of escape cum deliverance from this world of sin and death:

Mtt 4:16 The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up. **Vr.17** From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Mtt 6:31 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? **Vr.32** (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. **Vr.33** But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Christ, the Master taught us that those that are focused primarily on labouring for meat and drink all their lives in order to gain the whole world through acquiring abundance of wealth by accumulating mammon shall lose their souls to sin and death in this world at the end. Instead he enjoined us to learn of him and take on his own yoke, not that of the world that is bondage. Unfortunately, many are yet to heed this his call that is unto their spiritual liberation.

Mk 8:36 For what shall it profit a man, if He shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? **Vr.37** Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

Mtt 11:28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. **Vr.29** Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. **Vr.30** For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

Jn 6:26 Jesus answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled. **Vr.27** Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed.

Mtt 6:19 Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: **Vr.20** But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: **Vr.21** For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. **Vr.24** No man can serve two masters: for either He will hate the one, and love the other; or else He will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Lk 12:15 And he said unto them, Take heed, and beware of covetousness: for a man's life consisteth not in the abundance of the things which he possesseth.

Christ furthermore, taught us more of what the kingdom of God is about. For that is what we should seek for earnestly so that we could be among those to be called out of the world by God to become members of his body, the Church. And therefore be no longer members and lovers of this present world as children of the world still.

This is the primary purpose that you are meant to accomplish in this world even in becoming children of the kingdom cum the children of God. And it is strictly by the will and calling of God the Father for you in Christ Jesus. It is not of him that runneth nor of him that willeth, but by the mercy of God instead shown unto you. **Rom 9:15-16**

Jn 6:37 All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out. **Vr.64** But there are some of you that believe not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that believed not, and who should betray him. **Vr.65** And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father.

Jn 17:2 As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him. **Vr.3** And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent. **Vr.6** I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they

have kept thy word. **Vr.14** I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. **Vr.15** I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil. **Vr.16** They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. **Vr.17** Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. **Vr.18** As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.

Rom 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost. **Vr.18** For He that in these things serveth Christ is acceptable to God, and approved of men. **Vr.20** For meat destroy not the work of God.

You came into the world as a child of this world, but you are not meant to exit this world remaining the same, a child of the world. God has made provision for you to become His own child by the faith of Jesus Christ before your demise from this world. May this be your destiny in Jesus name. Amen. Christ has gone ahead of us, children of God, to prepare a heavenly place for us. So that wherever he is there we also shall be with him forever. **Mtt 25:34,41; Jn 12:26**

Jn 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. **Vr.7** Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again.

Jn 14:1-4 (Vr.2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. **Vr.3** And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

Let no man deceive you otherwise through vain religious conversations and rhetoric. Take heed what you hear and how you hear for that is your sole responsibility not that of another.

Those that remain as members of this world shall pass away with this world at the very end. While those that escape this world unto becoming members of the Body of Christ shall inherit the kingdom of heaven and abide forever more with Christ our Lord and Saviour.

I Jn 2:17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.

That is God's promise to those that believe the Truth that came by His Son, Jesus the Christ whom He sent to reconcile the world unto Himself. You came into this world not to pass away with the world at the end, but to experience the divine redemption from this evil world that God has made possible through His only begotten Son Jesus Christ in order to abide with him forever in his heavenly kingdom. God is a Spirit and ye must be born of the Spirit to become spirit too in the world to come, no longer walking after the flesh in the lusts thereof as they the that are of the world. **Jn 3:3-8**

2 Cor 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. **Vr.18** And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; **Vr.19** To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.
